# Behaviour Management



- Class Behaviour Chart
- Contact made with parents if children are sent to the reflection area.
- Phone call from Miss Mackay (Assistant Headteacher) if children are removed from class.
- If children are sent to the Headteacher's office then parents will be asked to come in for a formal meeting.
- If you have any concerns regarding your child then always approach the class teacher first. Please do not approach other parents.

# House Points



- Each child belongs to a house named after a rose.
- Your child can collect Water Droplets to help their rose grow.
- Water droplets are awarded to children who have shown outstanding behaviour or commitment to their learning.
- Each week the water droplets for each house are tallied up and the winning house receives the House Cup.
- The winning house's rose will also grow. This helps the children to see which house is in the lead for that half-term.
- On the last day of half-term the house with the tallest rose will be able to come to school wearing their house colours.

# Success Assembly



- Every Wednesday afternoon we hold a success assembly to celebrate the achievements and successes of the week.
- During this assembly we present a Golden Heart Award to one child from each class. The golden heart recipient is voted for by the children and selected for their kind heart and acts of kindness.
- An achiever of the week is also selected from each class. This is awarded to a child who has been outstanding during the week.
- A text message will be sent to you if your child has received either of these awards.

# Uniform



- Your child is required to wear our Academy uniform. You can find specific details on our website.
  - Proper black school shoes must be worn.
  - White collared shirt/blouse (no polo neck t-shirts).
  - Dark grey skirts/shorts/trousers/pinafore dresses.
  - Single stud earrings may be worn.
  - No nail polish of any colour.
  - Long hair must be tied back in school colours (black, grey, white)
  - No jewellery is to be worn in school.
- You will receive a call from the office staff if your child is not in the correct uniform.

# PE days



- Year 2 will have PE every Thursday.
- Each class will also have PE every other Tuesday.
- Please ensure that your child has their full PE kit in school.
- PE kit should contain:
  - Trainers or plimsolls
  - White top
  - Black trousers
  - Black shorts

# Home Learning



- Each Wednesday your child will be given a piece of either Maths OR English.
- It is due back in on the following Monday.
- Please ensure that you work with your child to complete it.



# Reading Books



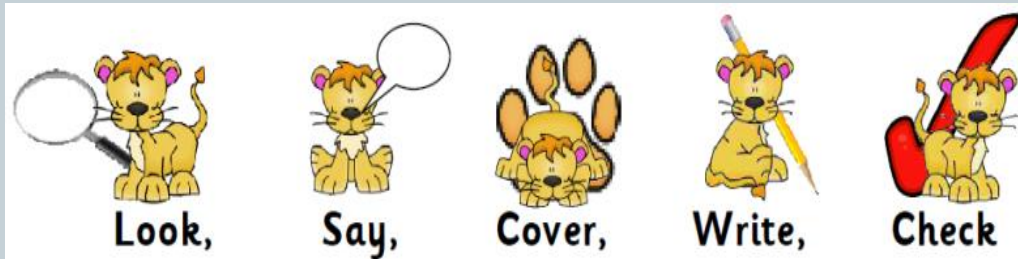
- Reading books will be changed on Friday.

# Spellings



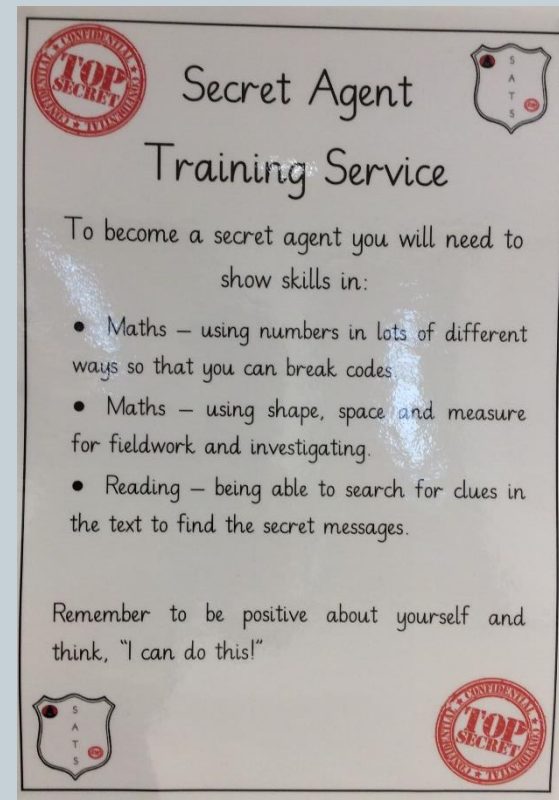
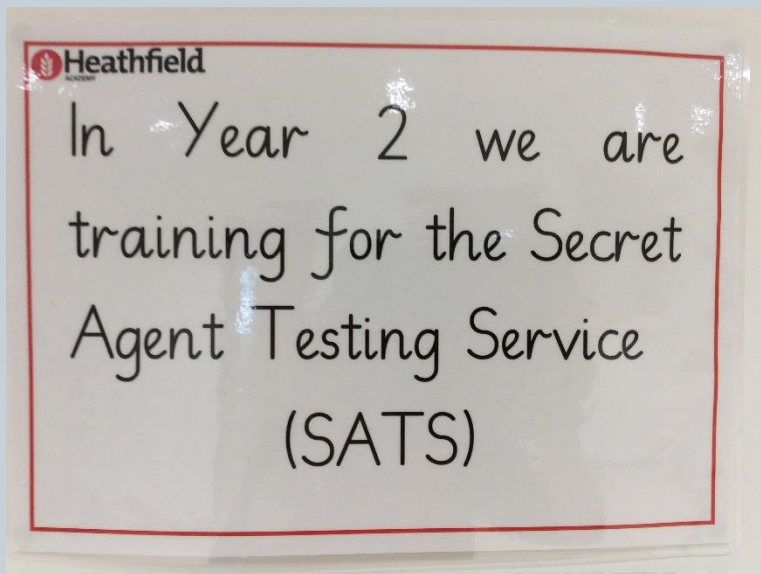
- Spellings will be given out on a Monday and tested the following Monday.

- Please ensure that we have your current email address in order for you to receive these updates.

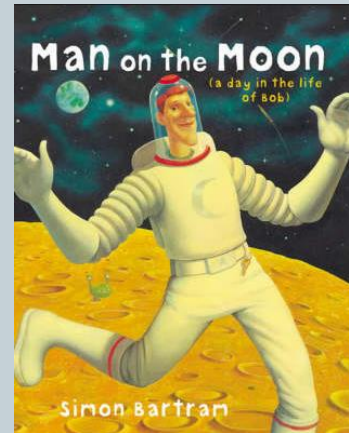
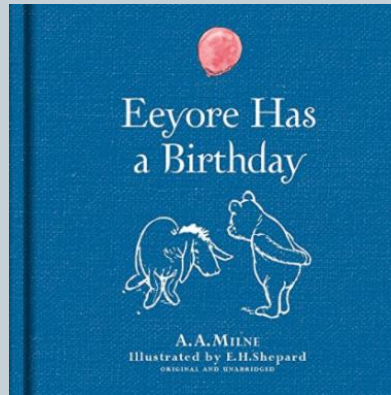
# Termly Reports
