Welcome Parents and Carers to the Year 2 SATs workshop.

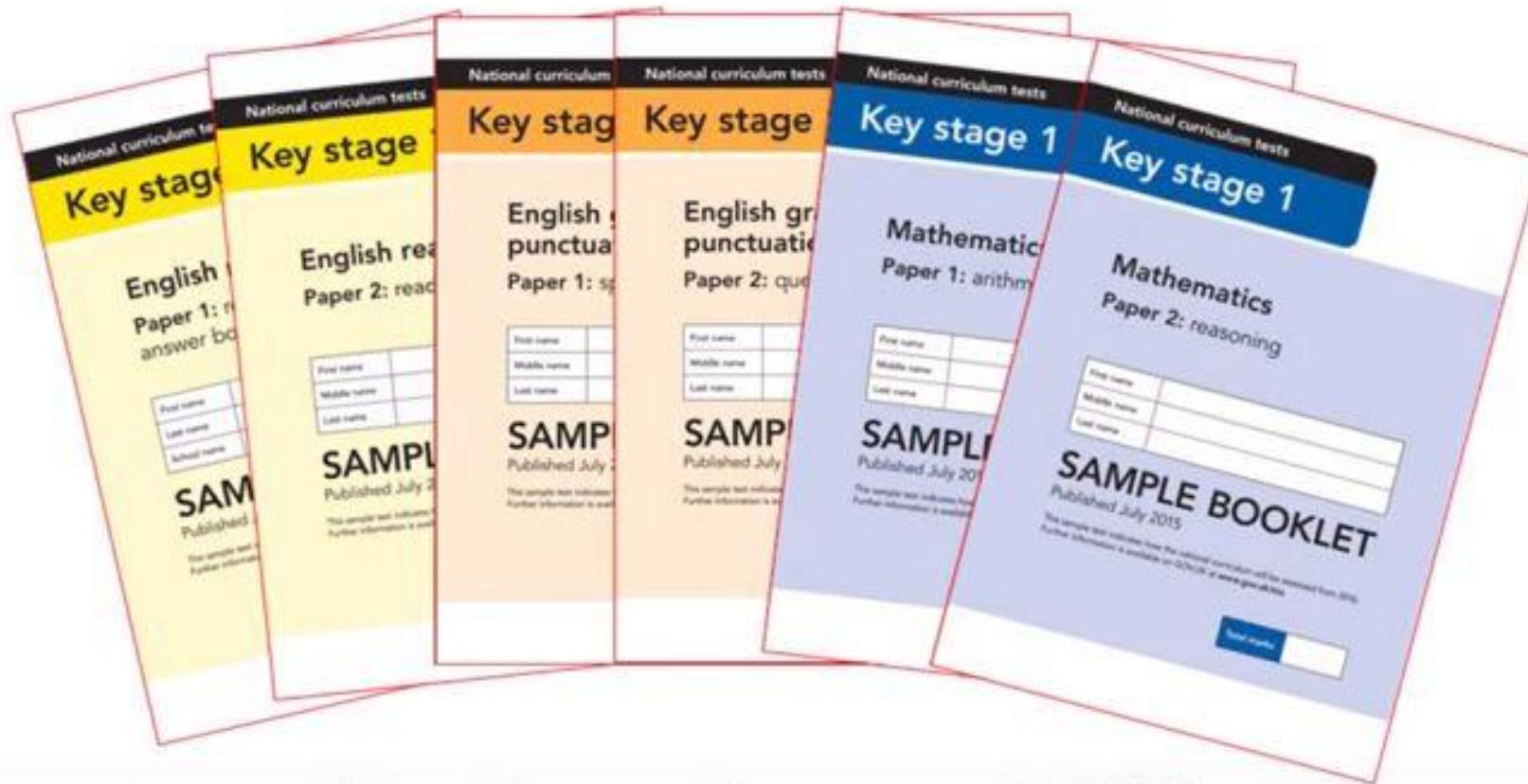
Today we will be providing you with more information about the Year 2 SATs

The SATs are Statutory Assessments set by Government and are compulsory for all children aged 6-7 years.

The purpose of the SATs tests is to assess the overall progress children have made across KSI (Years 1 and 2).



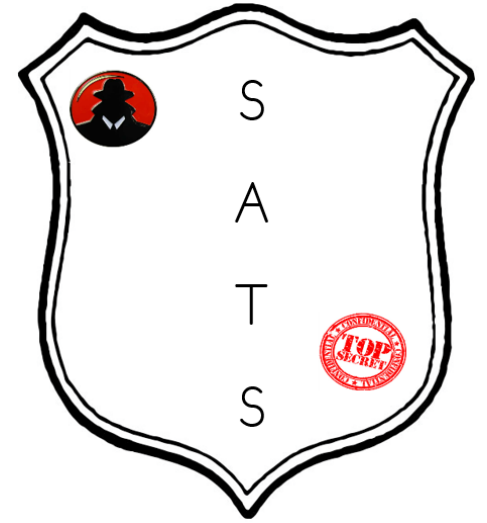
Here at Heathfield Academy we want the administration of the SATs to be as stress free as possible for our children.

In order to achieve this we have introduced the Secret Agent Training Service.

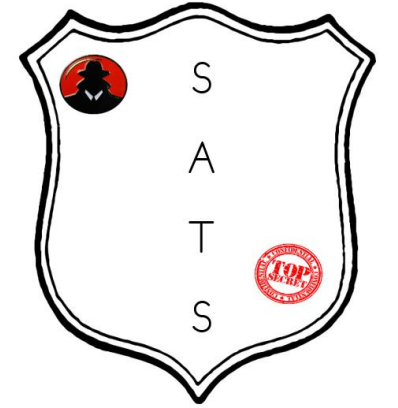
Secret Agent Training Service.

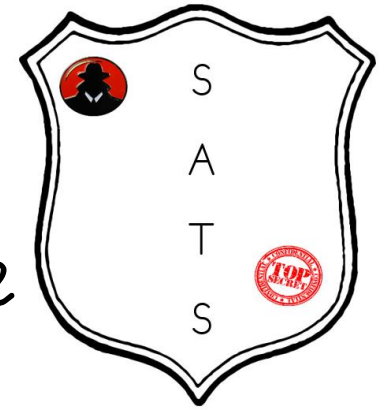
Over the next few months we will be encouraging your children to work hard to pass their Secret Agent Training Service tests (SATs).
